Please review the DVXC4 Viewing Angle Guideline before making your recoder adjustments

Locate the lock adjusting screw inside the center of the bracket (Photo A)

Using the supplied Alan Key, turn counter clockwise to loosen the screw (Photo B)

Do not remove the screw! Loosen enough to make your adjustment



Make your adjustments to your desired viewing angle by swinging the recorder forward and back (Photo C).

Turn the locking screw Clockwise to lock in your angle.

Do not overtighten the screw! Bracket damage may occur
